- ✓ Remove years of paint and filler
- ✓ Replace all broken parts and carve missing tails and manes
- ✓ Fill in any gaps in the body and limbs with wood
- ✓ Carefully sand
- ✓ Meticulously paint the details on the horses
- ✓ Apply a number of top coats to protect the finish
- ✓ Horse naming opportunity

SPECTACULAR HORSES 8 Available for Adoption

The Hunter (Lead Horse) 1-A With gun and rabbit, very elaborately carved (1)

The Dragon Horse 2-A A special Horse because of its visual relation to the Dragon on the Rounding Boards (1)

Lion Pelt Horses 14-A & 14-B Matched pair with Lion Pelts as saddle blankets, the lion head as the cantle (2). This pair is located side by side.

Flying Mane Horses 10-B & 13-A Two of the most signature of Parker's flamboyant style (2)

Partially-Armored Horses 2-B & 7-A With one of the flag cantles, makes him doubly "desirable" as rare Parkers (2)

Fish 1-B Silver Fish Cantle Design, jewels on left.

Rose & Flag 3-A Roses Cantle Design, U.S. Flag Side Carving, jewels on Right.

Rose & Flag 3-B Roses Cantle Design, tucked head, U.S. Side Flag Carving, jewels on Left.

Pinto 4-A Horns Cantle Design, U.S. Flag Stripes in triangle on right side of chest strap, jewels on Right. Painting style is that of a pinto.

Horns & Star 4-B Horns Cantle Design, Star carved on right side, jewels on Left. Only carved Star.

Puppy & Flag 5-A Puppy Cantle Design, tucked head, side U.S. Flag, jewels on Right.

Puppy & Tucked Head 5-B Puppy Cantle Design, Tucked Head, carved right side Scroll, jewels on Left.

Stargazer & Fish 6-A Silver Fish Cantle Design, Stargazer, jewels on Right.

Fish 6-B Silver Fish Cantle Design, jewels on Left.

Flag & Mane 7-B Flag Cantle Design, Peek-a-boo Mane, jewels on Left side.

Wild West 9-A Puppy Cantle Design, Gun & Lariat on Right, jewels on Right. Only one with Lariat

Puppy 9-B Puppy Cantle Design. Jewels on Right.

Stargazer and Horns 10-A Horns Cantle Design, Stargazer, jewels on chest strap.

Roses & Tucked Head 11-A Roses Cantle Design, Tucked Head, side drapery with Leaves & Flowers.

Roses 11-B Roses Cantle Design, jewels on Left.

Stargazer and Puppy 12-A Puppy Cantle Design, Stargazer, jewels on right.

Mane and Puppy 12-B Puppy Cantle Design, Clipped Mane, Neck Guard, jewels, on left.

Leaf Cantle 13-B Leaf Cantle Design, tucked head, jewels on Right. In. Only 1 with Leaf Cantle.

Puppy & Tucked Head 15-A Puppy Cantle Design, Tucked Head, jewels on Right.

Puppy 15-B Puppy Cantle Design, jewels on Right.

Please note that the numbers represent the order on the carousel while the letters indicate which ring the horse is located on – A indicates the outer ring while B identifies those horses on the inner ring.
